Our Mission

The Mitchell Thorp Foundation (**MTF**) Youth Leadership Council supports the Mission of **MTF** by planning and executing service projects and events which raise funds and increase awareness of **MTF** in the communities that we serve.

Activities

Primary focus areas of the group are community service and leadership development, with the objective of fostering the development of young leaders while developing life skills. Members will have the opportunity to plan and carry out activities and events in support of the Foundation's Mission (see last page). Members will also have the opportunity to participate in a structured leadership development program.

The team will also host a major event to be held in April/May 2019.

Team meetings will be held on Sunday mornings once per month between September and May. The program is a one year commitment.

Age Requirements

Students who are in good standing in Grades 7 thru 12 as of April 2018 are eligible to participate.

Team Fees

The team fee is \$100 per season, payable online. This fee includes Foundation attire, orientation meals and team-building activities, and snacks and/or meals provided at team meetings. Fees are refundable up until the completion of the interview process. Scholarships are available for financial assistance.
